

Legislation Report

Here is a quick update on where we are with legislation for our association and what's been going on since last year's AGM.

1. A committee was formed at the AGM and a couple of emails have been sent out to the committee members.
2. There was an update from the lawyer last month and the government has had talks again about legislation.

This is what she stated in her email to me:

"I should also note that at a recent meeting of the Health Network, there was renewed talk from government about bringing in a form of umbrella legislation to cover a variety of professions. The details are very vague, but we understand a consultation document will be coming soon. We will ensure you get it once we see it, as that will give a better idea of government's intentions for regulation of smaller professions in the future."

3. The question of funds in our accounts, and how much of a reserve we should have.
 - For a regular legal account for just day to day operations, the lawyer suggested \$ 5,000.00
 - For an account for when we become legislated, the lawyer suggested \$100,000.00 to maintain
